

## WYOMING WING ENCAMPMENT EQUIPMENT LIST

Use this list to prepare your uniforms and other equipment for encampment. The requirements listed are minimums necessary and you may wish to bring more of a particular item. Keep in mind however you must be able to easily carry everything you bring. Do NOT arrive at encampment without the items listed below, as you will have little time to purchase missing equipment, and uniform items will not be available. All items must be marked with your last name, the first initial of your first name, and your CAP serial number (Example: Schmidt, J. 221133). Uniform shirts and undershirts will be marked on the INSIDE of the shirt tail. Uniform pants will be marked on the label inside the pants. Underpants should be marked on the waistband.
